Dr Ed Mlavsky is one of the pioneers of the world-renowned high-tech industry in Israel. In the US, Ed became the first employee of Tyco, which is now a huge multinational conglomerate, working as a scientist, laboratory manager and business executive. He moved with his family to Israel in 1979, when he was appointed the executive director of BIRD - the Israel-US Binational Industrial Research & Development Foundation - where he initiated more than 300 projects involving a wide range of science-based industries. In 1993, Ed founded Gemini, Israel's first venture capital fund, and continues to serve as its Chairman.
